I am directed to inform you that the assessments to assess the standard of examination held by Dr. N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada and to assess the physical and the other teaching facilities available for Recognition/approval of Katuri Medical College & Hospital, Guntur for the award of MBBS degree granted by Dr. N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada against the increased intake i.e. from 100 to 150 seats u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956 were carried out by the Council assessors on 12.02.2016 and 18.04.2016 & 19.04.2016. The Assessment reports were considered by the Executive Committee at its meeting held on 13.05.2016. The following recommendations of the Executive Committee was approved by the General Body of the Council at its meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> November, 2016:-

*"The Executive Committee of the Council considered the assessment reports (12.02.2016 and 18 & 19 April, 2016) and decided to recommend to the Central Government for recognition/approval of Katuri Medical College & Hospital, Guntur for the award of MBBS degree granted by Dr. N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada against the increased intake i.e. from 100 to 150 seats u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.*

*The Executive Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Sections 8(3)(2), 8(3)(3) & 8(3)(4) of the Establishment of Medical Colleges Regulations (Amendment), 2010 (Part II) dated 16<sup>th</sup> April 2010 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-*

8 (3) ...

*(2) The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of MBBS degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.*

*(3) The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.*

*(4) Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute....."*

In view of above, you are requested to issue necessary notification at the earliest recognizing Katuri Medical College & Hospital, Guntur for the award of MBBS degree when granted on or after February, 2016 by Dr. N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada against the increased intake i.e. from 100 to 150 seats.



I am directed to inform you that an assessment to assess the physical and other teaching facilities available for renewal of permission for admission of 4<sup>th</sup> batch of MBBS students against the increased intake from 100 to 150 at Katuri Medical College & Hospital, Guntur under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada for the academic year 2014-15 u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 - Compliance Verification was carried out by the Council assessors on 9<sup>th</sup> June, 2014. The Assessment report was considered by the Executive Committee at its meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> June 2014 and it was decided as under:

"The Executive Committee of the Council considered the compliance verification report (9<sup>th</sup> June, 2014) and noted the following:-

1. Only 4 static X-ray machines are available. Deficiency is not rectified.
2. Shortage of Residents is 8.08 % (i.e. 11 out of 136) as detailed in report as under:
  - (a) Senior Resident: 2
  - (b) Junior Resident: 9
3. Faculty attendance sheets were not signed within the stipulated period. Attendance registers of college & hospital are not properly maintained.
4. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report

In view of the above, the Executive Committee of the Council decided to reiterate its earlier decision of recommending to the Central Govt. not to renew the permission for admission of 4<sup>th</sup> batch of MBBS students against the increased intake from 100 to 150 at Katuri Medical College & Hospital, Guntur under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada for the academic year 2014-15 u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956."





Please refer to your proposal for increase in MBBS seats from 100 to 150 at Katari Medical College & Hospital, Guntur, Andhra Pradesh.

In this connection, I am directed to inform you that after consideration of the scheme submitted by you and Assessment report dated (10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2011), the Board of Governors is of the opinion that a Letter of Intent for increase in MBBS seats from 100 to 150 at Katari Medical College & Hospital, Guntur, Andhra Pradesh u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 may be issued.

However, this letter of Intent is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:
